Instructions of Cover Letter

Manuscripts must be accompanied by a cover letter that should include information on prior or duplicate publication or submission, as well as the originality of the manuscript and any other information that the authors want to convey to the editor. If the manuscript is one of a series or tightly associated with papers published previously, the authors should clarify (including the journal name, paper title, publication date, *et al.*). And it is necessary to enclose the published paper. Moreover, the authors should indicate the column of manuscript, also can provide suggested or non-preferred reviewers. It would be very helpful for the early publication of the manuscript with recommendation letter of International famous scholars or professors in the field.

The principal investigator or the corresponding author of a manuscript containing original data must confirm in the cover letter that he or she has full access to all the data in the study and takes responsibility for the integrity of the data and the accuracy of the data analysis as well as the decision to submit for publication. The authors should declare that the manuscript has not been published previously, nor under consideration for publication elsewhere, in whole or in part, and has no conflict of signature and interest. The cover letter should also include brief introduction, detailed contact address and email address of the first author as well as the corresponding author. As for domestic authors, it would be better to attach the Chinese corresponding manuscript for the convenience of reviewers.
